# Cava, Prosecco & Champagne

**Ramiro II Cava Brut Nature** £6.35 – £25.95

*Spain*

This wonderfully crisp and fresh ecological cava is light yellow with green hues. Lovely persistent perlage and elegant aromas of apples, pear and a hint of lime. On the palate it is fresh, fruity and flowery. Intense and great complexity, with soft shades of lees.

In the mouth it's dry and cool with refreshing acidity.

**Vilarnau Cava Rosé Brut Reserva** £5.70 £20.65

*Spain*

A beautiful Vibrant pink, 18 months aged with wonderful strawberry fruit characters. Soft and juicy with perfectly balanced acidity.

**Bottega Gold – Prosecco Brut** £7.90 £35.35

*Italy*

A fresh and aromatic sparkling wine, with a nose of fruity & flowery scents. A prestigious choice for all occasions.

**Bottega Gold Rosé Prosecco Brut** £7.90 £36.95

A very elegant, Medium dry white with a floral aroma and notes of pears. Fruity & lively with balanced acidity and a long aftertaste.

**Ca Montini DOC** £5.55 £23.75

*Pinot Grigio - Trentino, Italy*

An award winning vibrant Pinot Grigio. Lemony fresh on the nose, with aromas of wet stone, apricot, pear and maraschino cherry. Dry and mineral on the palate. Notes of fresh green apple. A prestigious and excellent wine from Trentino.

**Vina Albina DOCa** £24.95

*Rioja, Spain*

A fine semi sweet with greenish yellow hues. The secret to this delicious wine resides in a perfect balance between its natural sugar content and acidity resulting in a charmingly discreet sweetness and an unforgettable fragrance.

*Rueda, Spain*

A pale golden yellow colour with aromas of pear, lemon and apple. With lovely notes of apples and citrus fruits. Crisp acidity with smooth mineral tones. Leading to a refreshing grapefruit finish.

**Riversong Viognier** £29.95

*Chile (V)*

A rich and refreshing dry white that is pale green gold in colour with aromas of tropical and stone fruits. Floral hints shine through. Perfectly balanced with notes of honeyed apricots, spice and peach.

**Muga** £30.95

*Viura, White Garnacha, Malvasia - Rioja, Spain*

A refreshingly lemony-yellow wine with green, youthful glints. Clean and floral on the nose with aromas of almond blossom. Wonderful citrus notes and toasted nuances with beautiful touch of apple. Good acidity and finish.

**J Moreau & Fils Chablis** £31.90

*North Burgundy - France*

100% Chardonnay. A delicate golden colour with green hues. Fresh, Lively and mineral. This Chablis has the perfect amount of acidity with intense aromas of white and citrus fruits, a tender floral bouquet that shines through along with butter and spice. Wonderfully dry with a unique personality.

**Idrias Gewurztraminer** £31.95

*DO Somontano, Spain*

This beautiful and fresh pale gold Gewurztraminer has a wonderfully complex nose of roses, lilac, violet, exotic fruit, lychees, and citrus peel. Full of character. In the mouth it is silky and elegant. Very well balanced with good acidity. Full bodied with a long finish.

**Tudanca Verdejo** £31.95

*Rueda, Spain*

A wonderfully intense and vibrant verdejo. Clean and bright. Tropical fruits of pineapple, mango and passion fruit with citrus hints. Refreshing with a long finish.

**Sula, Chenin Blanc** £23.50

*Nashik, India*

A delicious full bodied, semi dry white wine from the rolling valleys of Maharashtra. With aromas of quince and pear combined with tropical fruits and mineral undertones. Perfectly balanced acidity and a lovely finish.

**Mayfly Sauvignon Blanc** £32.99

*Marlborough, New Zealand*

Fresh, dry and fruity with aromas of fresh asparagus, tropical peach and lychee. Crisp acidity and a lovely long finish.

**Cloe Chardonnay** £33.95

*Ronda, Spain*

A beautifully bright yellow colour with hints of gold. Warm tropical fruit aromas with intense citrus undertones. On a bed of pine, hazelnuts and white flowers. Well defined with a lightly toasted, rich oak character.

**Tenimente Ca Bianca Gavi DOCG** £34.75

*Cortese - Piedmont, Italy*

A wonderfully refreshing clean, dry white from 100% Cortese grapes. With delicate notes of white flowers (lilac and hawthorn) & vanilla with fruit aromas of pear and citrus.

**Pago de Cirsus Chardonnay** £7.05 £34.95

*Navarra, Spain*

A beautiful Golden yellow wine from the Navarra region. Aged in French oak barrels. Wonderfully fresh aromas of tropical mango, banana, honey and pineapples with touches of citrus. This leads you on to soft honey, vanilla and touches of grapefruits and pineapple. The acidity balances the oak to perfection. A lovely long finish follows.

**Pazo Pondal Albarino DO** £36.95

*Rias Baixas, Spain*

Pazo Pondal a complex Albariño of three winemaking styles, aging in double lees and French oak barrels. For 8 months. Elegant symphony of aromas, with subtle floral notes, accompanied by different fruits which highlights the lemon pear, white peach and citrus, with aromatic plants, which are mixed with saline and mineral, acidic touch. Salinity and fruitiness stand out pleasantly, marking their personality. The end is wonderfully persistent.

**Lagar de Proventus Alvarinho** £36.95  
**Especialy bottled for Little Bay).**

*Douro, Portugal*

A truly delicious Portuguese wine that is fresh and vibrant with white flowers and succulent stone fruits. Citrus and tropical with a welcome touch of oak. Well balanced with a fabulous finish.

**Domaine Trapet Alsace** £43.40

*Riesling - Austria*

A stunning, fruity Riesling. Light straw colour with crisp acidity. Balanced by notes of apricot and citrus fruits. Leading into a long sweet and spicy finish.

**Cloudy Bay** £48.95

*Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough, New Zealand*

A beautifully aromatic wine of intense fresh herbs and vivid citrus mixed with gooseberry. Understandably award winning.

**Bartenura Moscato (Kosher)** bottle £10.45

*Provincia Di Pavia IGP, Italy*

The Moscato grape is naturally rich in perfume. This producer has preserved the aromas in the finished wine that is served in novel cans.

Only the best grapes are used and fermentation takes place at low temperature to keep the fresh peachy perfumes and light grape flavours. Sweet and extremely enjoyable.

Silky, well rounded and smooth on the palate. A perfect balance between sweet and acidic.

A delicate salmon pink Rosé, which is both crisp and refreshing. Beautifully dry and elegant.

**Notorious Pink**

*Grenache, South of France*

A beautiful pale pink that exudes floral orange blossom and peach aromas. Elegantly classic with mature, ripe berries, melons and sweet cherry that gives a wonderful acidity and soft minerality.

**Astoria Moscato Rose**

This refreshing and extremely fruity Sparkling Moscato is just like a fruit salad in a glass. The bouquet is dominated by peach and strawberry aromas with a hint of sage in the background. The palate is delicately sweet but with a refreshing acidity to make the wine really come alive.

A very clean and bright, pale salmon with a lovely nude trim and gold tints. On the nose high aromatic intensity, with notes of acidic red fruits of strawberry and raspberry. Notes of pine, passion fruit, citrus and floral hints. Fresh and a wonderful accompaniment to several of our dishes.

*Languedoc, Southern France*

Made by young designer Ecole Boule, this bottle is offered as a bouquet of roses!

Soft, pale, yet brilliant pink with bluish tints. Fresh aromas of cassis, redcurrants, rose and gentle hints of grapefruits. Elegant and softly persistent.

**Ott Chateau Romassan, AOC Bandol**

*Provence, France.*

A distinguished elegance. Pale pink, tinted with gold. Releasing a bouquet of citrus fruits and white orchard flowers. On the palate you have pink grapefruit and fleshy fruits. With a complex and lasting finish.

**Carmen Comenge** £35.95

*Ribera del Duero, Spain*

A lovely pale pink in colour with steel highlights. An intense nose of ripe black fruits, wild blackberries, white flowers, lavender and minerals.

Excellent acidity fresh and light with a delicate texture. Reminiscent of walking through the vineyards of where this scarce rose is born.

## Red Wines

**J Moreau & Fils** £5.05 £22.95

*France*

A dry, smooth textured ruby red, tinged with violet. Intense nose with notes of red berries, coffee and caramel. Fruity, full bodied and silky.

**Emilio Moro Finca Resalso** £6.05 £24.95

*Ribera del Duero, Spain*

A wonderful spice, berry and plum tempranillo. Mild and oaky.

**Idrias Roble** £5.80 £29.95

*Somontano, Spain*

Intense cherry red colour, with aromas of fruits of the forest, spices and cacao. Juicy fruit and balanced tannins. Very easy and elegant to drink.

**Bordon Crianza** £5.65 £32.95

*Rioja, Spain*

A lovely deep cherry red with a ruby rim. Red fruit overtones in aroma with soft smoke and liquorice. Clean and fresh with smooth tannin. Balanced with a long finish that is fruity yet spicy.

**Corte Fiore Appassimento** £27.00

*Abruzzo, Italy*

Deep ruby red, with aromas of well ripened fruit; wild cherries and dried plums. Complex, balanced with full body and length. A sweetness of ripe tannins complement this wine perfectly.

**Montebaco Semele Crianza** £33.00

*Ribera del Duero - Spain*

A sumptuously rich cherry red with aromas of ripe black fruits, oak age nuances of clove, cinnamon, coconut and liquorice. Fabulous notes of chocolate and coffee balance this award winning wine perfectly.

**Torres Celeste Crianza** £29.50

*Ribera del Duero, Spain*

An opulent wine, brimming with fruit, body and colour. Dark cherry red with garnet hints. Aromas of black fruits and toasted notes of coffee. Oak aged with velvety tannins.

**Diemersfontein Carpe Diem** £58.95

**Malbec Reserve**

*Western Cape, South Africa*

This rich, bold and intense yet smooth Malbec Reserve is a decadent blend of berries and plums. Mixed berries and plums on the first nose leading to liquorice, cherry and tobacco. Full and robust in mouth with dark berries and fine tannins. Warm and velvety going down with a good lingering fruity finish.

**Habla del Silencio, Crianza** £26.95

*Extramadura, Spain*

Intense garnet with violet hues. Wonderfully complex with aromas of chocolate and liquorice. Notes of cherry, blackberry, mint and pepper. Fresh in the mouth with an elegant finish.

**Tussock Jumper Western Cape** £26.50

*Shiraz - Grenache - Viognier, South Africa*

Rhino. A rich ruby red with an aromatic freshness. Aromas of black olive, leather, berries, light oak, spices, vanilla, dark coffee and liquorice. This perfectly balanced dry red has notes on the palate of red fruits, wood, liquorice, spices and hints of tobacco that remain on the elegant finish.

**Sula, Shiraz Cabernet** £31.90

*Nashik, India*

Coming from the luscious valley's of Nashik in Maharashtra, India's finest selling wine. Silky and earthy, full of dark cherries, pepper and mocha notes. Hints of spice shine through in this excellent wine.

**Corona de Aragon Club Barrica Reserva** £36.95  
**Especially bottled for Little Bay.**

*Tempranillo, Garnacha, Syrah - Cariñena, Spain*

A vibrantly bright deep cherry red with a nose of ripe red fruits and berries smooth and spicy with toasted notes of cocoa and liquorice. Gentle but intense. Elegantly complex with a long finish.

**Macho Man Monastrall DOP, Casa Rojo** £33.95

*Jumilla, La Raja*

Made from Monastrall grapes of thirteen different vineyards. Aromas of rosemary, thyme and menthol. A unique, long, fresh and elegant wine with earthy flavours.

**Chateau les Riganes (Kosher)** £33.95

*Bordeaux, France*

This red Bordeaux expresses the finest qualities of Entre-Deux-Mers, located in the heart of the Bordeaux region in the fork of the Gironds River. Its colour is a medium purple with a ruby brightness around the edges. The aroma is clean, with smells of an earthy forest floor with subtle notes of blackberries and blueberries. It has a medium body with medium acidity and with more blackberries and blueberries in the flavour. The finish is smooth with light tannins making this wine smooth and easy to drink.

Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon, and Sauvignon Blanc.

**Villa Antinori IGT** £34.95

*Tuscany, Italy*

Intense ruby red and very complex on the nose. Red fruit along with berry fruits and mint. Well balanced with spices and vanilla. Rounded and supple with silky tannins.

**Muga Reserva** £37.99

*La Rioja, Spain*

A deep cherry red with garnet hues. Rich aromas of blackberries, fennel and heathland. Well balanced with smoky aromas of vanilla and coffee. Elegant acidity leading to a perfect finish.

**Emilio Moro Crianza** £38.95

*Ribera del Duero, Spain*

A beautiful deep and elegant wine with spicy, aromatic nuances. Rich red fruits enveloped with hints of toasty oak. Well balanced and great drinking.

**Michelangelo de Caravaggio** £39.95

*Emilia, Italy*

Delicious, bright jammy red fruits; bursting with cranberries and redcurrants. Leading on to a cherry liquor taste. Soft tannins and balanced acidity with a warm, oaky chocolate finish.

**Viña Pomal Reserva DOC** £36.95

*Tempranillo, Spain*

Richer than the classic Rioja and bursting with berry fruits. The palate is clean intense and persistent. Perfectly balanced with soft tannins. Delicious from start to finish.

**Heresie AOP Corbieres** £37.95

*South of France*

Hérésie is the expression of a Corbières cuvée that symbolises and transcends the history of the knights of the South of France. Emblematic terroirs have been meticulously selected to produce this wine of great

elegance: arid hillsides for the Mourvèdre and Grenache and cooler areas for the Syrah.

A silky deep purple red with aromas of black fruits, cassis and spices. Beautifully complex with notes of liquorice and herbs. Powerful yet balanced with velvety tannins making it utterly moreish.

**Pago Florentino** £38.95

Cencibel, Castilla De La Mancha, Spain

A deliciously youthful, fresh and fruity dark cherry red wine. Ripe forest fruits, purple flowers and the smoky warmth of balsamic spices. Wonderfully balanced with sweet fruity tones and a gentle roasted flavour. The finish is long and velvety.

**Manos Negras Pinot Noir** £42.95

*Rio Negro, Patagonia, Argentina*

A truly special Pinot Noir fermented with wild yeast. The beautiful colour is the result of the vineyards being planted in rich red soil. Hence the name from caring for the grapes. With delicious autumn orchard fruits and rich plums leading to lovely earthy spice, warm chocolate and soft oak.

**Terrazas De Los Andes, Malbec Reserva** £44.95

*Mendoza, Argentina*

Beautiful deep purple with red shades. Delicate floral notes and wonderful red fruit aromas with toasted coffee and chocolate. Great tannins and a long finish.

**Pago De Cirsus Seleccion De Familia, Syrah – Tempranillo** £47.99

*Navarra, Spain*

A beautiful red that was created to the winemaker's family's taste. What resulted was a wine too good not to share with the world.

Balanced, powerful red with round and silky tannins. Remarkable aromatic richness. Plums and hints of spices like cinnamon and cloves. Good structure, bright balance, smooth on the palate with a long and firm finish.

**Chento Malbec** £52.85

*Mendoza,*

The Chento Vineyard Selection Lalbev has a profound dark, violet colour. In the nose it has black fruits, spices, and violet aromas followed by some mineral and graphite notes. Great concentration and very well balanced acidity along with soft, silky tannins, ripe plum, and chocolate flavours on the persistent finish.

**Buena Vista Pinot Noir, Carneros** £54.99

*Napa-Sonoma, California*

Deep cherry colour, that's dry, tannic and silky. Notes of pomegranate, cola, and cherry skins with a delicious complexion of Portobello mushrooms. Even better when decanted.

**Chateau Canteloup Medoc (Kosher)** £55.00

*Bordeaux, France*

Good steady garnet colour. Pretty fine, good presence, very fruity with a light hint of spice. Supple, with many aromas, strong balance, fine tannins with well-founded qualities, the memory is lasting and delicately wooded. Varietal: Merlot 55%, Cabernet Sauvignon 45%.

**Vieux Chantecaille Saint-Emilion Grand Cru** £62.00

*Bordeaux, France*

A very deep, bright cherry red in colour. The nose is fruity, elegant and racy. It reveals notes of redcurrant, blackcurrant, blackberry and fine notes of cassis. The palate is silky and fruity. Fresh and mineral with delicate notes of liquorice, toasted oak and coffee. Fine and elegant tannins perfect this wine.

**Tudanca Vicenta Mater, Tempranillo** £64.00

*Ribera del Duero DO, Spain*

An intense fragrantly fruity red with well integrated roasted and spicy notes. Fresh mint and liquorice combined with complex tannins give a wonderfully dense mouth feel. Well balanced and pleasantly long lingering.

**Domaine Belle, Crozes Hermitage** £68.85

*Syrah, Larnage, France*

Beautiful cherry red organic wine and full of juicy black fruits. Wonderful aromas of blackberry, black cherry, plum, bayleaf and soft lavender. Soft ripe tannins and a long finish.

**Tr3smano Vendimia** £73.95

*Ribera del Duero, Spain*

A meticulously selected tempranillo handpicked in small boxes. This wonderfully rich cherry red has excellent depth with an outstanding concentration of ripe red fruits and new wood on the nose. These build on the palate with toasted and smoked notes of toffee, coffee and cocoa along with spiced pepper. A fleshy, complex yet elegant wine with silky tannins that have a great duration of length in the mouth. A must for wine lovers.

**Dominio De Pingus Psi** £74.99

*Ribera del Duero, Spain*

Psi is a smooth red wine with intense but refreshing aromas of strawberries & raspberries and wonderful toasted notes of roasted coffee. Hints of black pepper give warmth. Well rounded and structured with spicy tannins and a wonderful finish.

**200 Monges Reserva D.O.C.a** £74.95

*Rioja, Spain*

A deep velvety red colour with intense fruity aromas of ripe red fruits, snuff, liquorice, cedar and truffle. Full bodied, well balanced and fabulous tannins. Long and silky elegant finish. A joy to drink.

**Astoria Amarone Della Valpolicella DOCG** £80.95

*Veneto, Italy*

Made from a special blend of Corvina Veronese, Corvinone and Rondinella grapes. This wine is for serious wine lovers! A deep, intense ruby red crowned with a garnet hue. Spicy notes of leather and cinnamon with hints of blackcurrant and cranberries envelope the soft tannins and full body. Perfected by the long yet soft raisin finish. Best enjoyed when decanted and left to breathe.

**Chateau De Ferrand GCC** £92.00

A dark intense ruby red. On the palate rich red and black fruits shine through. The elegance, purity and finesse of these aromas are very perceptible. Well balanced tannins make this a fresh and elegant vintage.

**Vega Sicilia Valbuena** £164.00

*Ribera del Duero, Spain*

But what you're going to love about Gin Mare is its smoothness and the way that traditional gin flavours like juniper and citrus still shine. This is a unique and very enjoyable contemporary gin.

### Silent Pool £6.00

Silent Pool Gin is classic gin at heart. Full-bodied and fresh with depth, clarity and above all else, flavour. It's a rich, clean, juniper-driven spirit with floral layers of lavender and chamomile. Fresh notes of citrus and kaffir lime are grounded with the subtle sweetness of local honey, creating a well-balanced gin that's both traditional and refreshingly individual.

### Botanist Islay Dry Gin £6.10

Rich and Mellow, cool on entry then warming across the palate, stimulating the taste buds with a round mouthfeel and citrus freshness. The balance and complexity are distinctive. Sweet and earthy notes combine with the delicate floral and herbal notes of Islay 22.

### G'Vine Floraison £6.20

Distilled from the Ugni Blanc or Trebbiano grape. The palate is complex and exciting. First some floral notes capture the attention. A high proof spirit. The term “proof” comes from the method whereby sailors could assure their rum rations weren’t being watered down. The ship’s captain would ladle out a sample from the day’s rum barrel in front of the men. He’d douse it with gunpowder, then give it a spark – if the rum was full strength, the powder ignited, giving the sailors “proof” of the integrity of their rum. Wonderful flavours of vanilla and oak with hints of clove and cinnamon spices

### Plantation Xaymaca (Jamaican Rum) £6.25

### Glen Garioch 12 YO £6.00

A wonderfully rich, mouth filling single malt. Full of dried fruit and mocha notes with toasty oak. To taste enjoy smooth spices, fresh heather, poached pears and hints of coffee.

### Laphroaig 10YO Islay £6.25

Peat Smoke, seaweed scent and a 'medicinal' essence hit the nose with a hit of sweetness.

### Glenmorangie The Original £6.25

Delicate notes of candied apple, light toffee and pear drops... nuances of rose petals, carnations and lightly toasted malt. The first taste notes are grainy and moderately sweet leading onto a burst of red pepper surrounded by tastes of pears, peaches, mushrooms.

### Glenlivet Distillers Reserve £7.00

Very thick and rich. A massive mouthful of malt and Sherry with good fruity sweetness, but also a wonderful sweetness. Big, powerful peat and oaky. Long, spicy finish, figs, dates, peat smoke, vanilla.

**Glenfiddich 18YO** £9.00

An award winning single malt that is a fabulous light copper gold giving us a hint as to the warm aromas of vanilla, fruit, cinnamon and chocolate. On the palate we have juicy red apples, cinnamon, honey and candied fruits and smoky oak. The finish is sweet and salty.

## Japanese Spirits (4Cl)

**Sake Choya Junmai** £5.50

Aromas of Dairy and Dried fruit notes. In the mouth we find the memory of rice and nuances of apple and balsamic.

**Nikka days** £6.50

Smooth and creamy, roasted nuts, toffee apple, toasty malted cereal and vanilla fudge alongside a hint of barrel char, freshened up by juicy apples.

**Sadashi** £6.75

Fresh oakiness with a touch of honey nectar, malt, a hint of citrus, coffee beans and spicy sandalwood on the back of the palate.

Hennessy XO (Extra Old) is a blend of 100 year old eaux-de-vie. Rich in dried-fruit aromas such as prunes and dried fig. The aromas evolve to more dense notes of chocolate and black pepper, mellowed by cinnamon, clove and cardamom. Very balanced on the palate, underlined by the strength of peppery notes and vegetable fragrances from the oak. A lovely long aftertaste is enrobed in velvet, conferring the last sweet notes of cinnamon and vanilla.
